



CONCUSSION BASELINE TESTING PROGRAM

HCA VA Sports Medicine now offers Concussion Baseline testing with the use of the Impact Test, a neurocognitive computer based testing program. Your child can be tested at their school through previously arranged test dates announced throughout the year or at our office location by calling (804) 560 – 6500 and asking for an appointment at our Boulders office.

When performed at your school, this is an “opt-in” option and you are under no obligation to have your child receive one. If you opt-in, the cost is \$ 5.00 paid to the school. Baseline tests are valid for 12 year olds and above, and are valid for 2 years from the date performed, unless a concussion is sustained. A new baseline test must be performed before the next school year, when a concussion is sustained the previous school year, for the baseline to be valid. The baseline data will be securely maintained according to all HIPAA/HITECH regulations.

If your child sustains a suspected concussion, it is always the parent/guardians’ choice where to take their child for further evaluation. If this occurs in a school in Chesterfield County, the Certified Athletic Trainer assigned at the high school will perform a “post-injury” Impact Test usually within 24 – 48 hours, unless the athlete is sent by EMS to the E.D. In all cases, the baseline and post-injury test data will be sent “encrypted” by e-mail to whichever physician the parent/guardian chooses. Time constraints prevent it being sent to an E.D.
